1. Wave phenomena transmit energy through various states of matter by setting up patterns of oscillatory motion in the particles that make up the matter.
2. Most of the waves observed at sea are progressive wind waves, i.e. they are generated by winds. The distance over water, where the wind blows in a single direction is called as fetch.
3. Progressive waves are longitudinal, transverse, or orbital depending on the pattern of particle oscillation particles in ocean move primarily in orbital paths.
4. Characteristics used to describe waves are wave length (L), wave height (H), wave period (T) and wave speed (S).
5. If water depth is greater than 14 wave lengths, a progressive wave travels as a deep water wave with a speed that is directly proportional to wavelength.

पॉलीथीन बैग-पर्यावरण एवं हमारी सेहत के लिए खतरा

पॉलीथीन बैग आज हमारे दैनिक जीवन का अहम हिस्सा बन चुका है। लेकिन बहुत कम लोग यह महसूस करते हैं कि यह छोटी सी सुविधा हमारे पर्यावरण और सेहत के लिए कितना नुकसान दायक है।

जब से पॉलीथीन बैग कारखानों में बनता है तभी से यह हमारे पर्यावरण को प्रभावित करने लगता है। अधिकतर पालीथीन बैग निम्न गुणवत्ता वाले प्लास्टिक से बनते हैं। प्लास्टिक गलाने पर खतरनाक गैसों निकलती हैं जो हमारे पर्यावरण और सेहत के लिए हानिकारक हैं। पॉलीथीन बैग में खाद्य सामग्री रखने पर उनकी गुणवत्ता भी प्रभावित होती है। अगर इनको उपयोग करने के बाद फेंक दिया जाए तो इससे सीवर लाईन तथा नालियाँ अवरुद्ध हो जाती हैं। अगर इनको जलाया जाए तो इनसे कार्बन मोने ऑक्साइड, नाइट्रोजन डाईऑक्साइड, फॉस्जीन जैसी हानिकारक गैसों निकलती हैं। अगर इन्हें गड़ढे में दबाया जाए तो इनसे सीसा (लेड), कैल्शियम जैसे भारी रसायन बनते हैं जो जमीन की उर्वरक क्षमता को घटाते हैं। जब वर्षा का पानी रिसकर जमीन में जाता है वह भी दूषित हो जाता है।

इस खतरे का मुकाबला केवल सरकारी नियम या कानून बनाकर नहीं किया जा सकता। इसके लिए सभी के योगदान की जरूरत है। प्रत्येक नागरिक को इनके विनाशकारी प्रभाव से सचेत रहना चाहिए तथा पर्यावरण को बचाने के लिए पॉलीथीन बैग का प्रयोग बंद करना चाहिए।



5. Drink a glass of water.
6. Wash your face.
7. Divert your attention through music.
8. Change the subjects of discussion which is anger provoking.
9. Try to relax by meditation.

Remember, if you fail to make up your mind on these methods, surrender honestly to the ever respecting authority of our worthy teachers.


