They are showing excellent result on the academic side as well as developing all round personalities to face bigger challenges of life.



## प्रदूषित पर्यावरण

पर्यावरण का अर्थ है हमारे चारों ओर पाया जाने वाला वातावरण और प्रदूषण का अर्थ है— किन्हीं कारणों से वातावरण का दूषित हो जाना। प्रकृति ने तो प्रत्येक जीव को स्वस्थ बनाए रखने के लिए जीवन-दायिनी शुद्ध हवा, जल और वनस्पति दी है, परन्तु मनुष्य ने विज्ञान में तरक्की करके भौतिक सुख-सुविधाएं प्राप्त कर ली हैं। जहां इनसे हमें सुख प्राप्त हुआ है वहीं इनके दुरुप्रयोग से पर्यावरण को बहुत अधिक क्षति भी पहुंची है।

प्रदूषण चार प्रकार का होता है— वायु प्रदूषण, जल-प्रदूषण, ध्वनि प्रदूषण और भूमि प्रदूषण। वायु हर प्राणी का जीवन है। यह वायु जब विषैली होकर किसी प्राणी के अन्दर प्रवेश करती है, तो यह तरह-तरह के रोगों को जन्म देती है। जल प्रदूषण का मुख्य कारण कारखानों से निकलने वाले अपशिष्टों को नदियों में बहाया जाना है। इससे नदियों का जल दूषित होता है एवं प्राणघातक रोगों को जन्म देता है। ध्वनि प्रदूषण का मुख्य कारण गाड़ियों से निकलने वाला शोर, पटाखे इत्यादि से निकलने वाला शोर है, जिनसे हानिकारक रोगों का जन्म हो रहा है। भूमि में रासायनिक पदार्थों को मिलाने से उसकी उर्वरा शक्ति का हास हो रहा जिससे भूमि प्रदूषण भी बढ़ रहा।

अब प्रश्न यह है कि क्या विद्यार्थियों को राजनीति में भाग लेना चाहिए या नहीं? तो मेरा यह मत है कि विद्यार्थियों को राजनीति में भाग अवश्य लेना चाहिए, क्योंकि भारत एक गणतंत्र देश है। आज का विद्यार्थी ही भावी राष्ट्र का निर्माता है, कर्णधार है, भविष्य में उसी को एक अच्छा राजनीतिज्ञ बनना है और इसके लिए उसे अपने विद्यार्थी-काल से ही अभ्यास करना चाहिए। इसका अर्थ यह नहीं है कि विद्यार्थी को अपनी पढ़ाई छोड़ देनी चाहिए। मैं तो मात्र यह कहना चाहूंगा कि विद्यार्थी को पढ़ाई के साथ-साथ राजनैतिक कार्यों की गहराईयों को भी समझना चाहिए। जिससे वह अपना स्वस्थ राजनैतिक दृष्टिकोण बना सके। यदि वह इस समय राजनैतिक कार्यों में भाग नहीं लेगा, तो भविष्य में वह एक अच्छा राजनीतिज्ञ कभी नहीं बन पायेगा।

उदाहरण के लिए—एक अच्छा खिलाड़ी वही बनता है जो निरंतर अभ्यास करता है। यदि हम चाहें कि हम अघानक से डॉक्टर या इंजीनियर बन जायें तो क्या यह सम्भव है? नहीं। पहले हमें इस क्षेत्र में जाना होगा, अनुभव से चीजें सीखनी होंगी और तभी हम उस क्षेत्र के विशेषज्ञ कहलायेंगे, अन्यथा नहीं। ठीक इसी प्रकार राजनीति में आने का बिल्कुल उचित समय है। परंतु आज विद्यार्थियों को राजनीति में आने से रोका जाता है। विद्यार्थियों को राजनीति के सिर्फ नकारात्मक पहलुओं से ही दो-चार करवाया जाता है जिससे विद्यार्थियों का जोश व उत्साह पश्चाष्ट हो रहा है। आज हो रही अस्वस्थ राजनीति का यह प्रमुख कारण है।

अब आप ही बताइये क्या विद्यार्थियों को राजनीति का भूक दर्शक बनना उचित है? यदि विद्यार्थी ही इस अहम भूमिका से दूर हो जायेगा तो देश को अच्छी सरकार व ईमानदार नेता कहां से मिलेंगे। एक देश की सरकार या तो अपने देश को बुलंदी पर पहुंचा सकती है या फिर नेस्तनाबूत कर सकती है तो हम क्या चाहते हैं— तरक्की या गरीबी? स्वभाविक है कि हम सब तरक्की ही चाहेंगे और इसके लिए विद्यार्थियों को राजनीति में आना ही पड़ेगा।

इतिहास गवाह है कि गांधी जी ने भी देश के स्वतंत्रता आन्दोलन में छात्रों को आमंत्रित किया था। भगत सिंह, सुखदेव, राजगुरु जिनकी याद करके गर्व से हमारे रोंगटे खड़े हो जाते हैं, ये महान नेता भी तो विद्यार्थी ही थे।

अंत में मैं यही कहना चाहूंगी कि गांधी जी, सुभाष जी जैसे नेताओं के नाम पर हमें आह भरने की आवश्यकता नहीं क्योंकि आज भी ये महान नेता हम विद्यार्थियों के भीतर ही मौजूद हैं, बस आवश्यकता है तो सही मार्ग—दर्शन की। यदि ऐसा हुआ तो एक नहीं बल्कि कितने ही गांधी, सुभाष, भगत सिंह होंगे। और तब नये भारत का निर्माण होगा जो फिर से सोने की चिड़िया कहलाएगा।
